PETITIONER'S MOTION TO SUSPEND FURTHER PROCEEDINGS

Pabst Brewing Company, Petitioner in the above-styled and numbered proceeding, hereby moves that all further proceedings in this cancellation be stayed pending resolution of Civil Action No. SA06CA0444 now pending in the United States District Court for the Western District of Texas, San Antonio Division. A true and correct copy of the Complaint in that action is attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

It is proper for the Trademark Trial and Appeal Board (the "Board") to suspend a pending cancellation once the Board is notified that the parties to the pending cancellation are involved in a civil action which may have a bearing on the Board case. See 37 CFR 2.117(a). Suspension of a cancellation proceeding based on a civil action brought in federal district court is especially appropriate based on the fact that a federal district court's decision is binding upon the Board, but the Board's decision is not binding upon a federal district court. TMBP 510.02(a); Goya Foods Inc. v. Tropicana Products, Inc., 845 F.2d 848 (2nd Cir. 1988).

As indicated by the contents of the Complaint, the issues presented in Civil Action No. SA06CA0444 involve the Registrant's right to use the LONE STAR SPRINGS mark that is at issue in the pending cancellation. Because the issues to be resolved by the federal district court



have a bearing on the issues before the Board in the instant cancellation, and because the federal district court's decision will be binding on the Board, the Board should suspend the pending cancellation.

WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests that the Board grant this Motion to Suspend Further Proceedings in its entirety, suspend this cancellation pending the final disposition of Civil Action No. SA06CA0444 now pending in the United States District Court for the Western District of Texas, San Antonio Division, and award Petitioner all such other and further relief to which it may be justly entitled.
