PETITIONER'S MOTION TO SUSPEND PROCEEDINGS FOR CIVIL ACTION

Petitioner PLAYDOM, INC. ("Playdom") respectfully requests that the Board suspend this cancellation proceeding pending final disposition of a civil action before the U.S. District Court for the District of New Hampshire, *David Couture v. Playdom, Inc.*, Civil Action No. 10-CV-440 (the "Action"), which was filed by Registrant DAVID COUTURE ("Couture") against Playdom on September 28, 2010. *See* Trademark Rule 2.127(a) and 2.117(a), 37 C.F.R. §§ 2.127(a) and 2.117(a). A true and correct copy of Complaint and Civil Cover Sheet filed by Couture in the Action are attached as Exhibit A hereto.

Both Playdom and Couture are parties to the Action, which involves common issues of law and fact that may have a bearing on this cancellation proceeding. In particular, the Action involves claims of, among other things, trademark infringement, false designation of origin, and common law trademark infringement concerning the marks and services at issue in this case.

Further, in the Action, Couture has alleged rights in U.S. Registration No. 3560701, which is the subject of this cancellation proceeding. In view of the common issues of law and fact between
