ORDER SETTING EVIDENTIARY HEARING ON MOTION

The Court issues this Order *sua sponte*. The Court recently set Defendant LG Electronics, Inc.'s ("LGEKR") Motion to Dismiss for Lack of Personal Jurisdiction or Transfer for Convenience, (Dkt.
