Based on the Siegel Patents (Dkt. 234). Having considered the Joint Motion, the Court finds that the Motion should be and is hereby **GRANTED**.

It is further **ORDERED** that the deadline for Defendant Apple Inc. to file its oppositions to Plaintiff AGIS Software Development LLC's Opposed Motion to Strike Portions of the Expert Report of Neil Siegel Relating to the Undisclosed Invalidity Theory Based on "Dynamically Electing Servers" (Dkt. 233) and Plaintiff AGIS Software Development LLC's Opposed Motion to Strike the Expert Report of Neil Siegel for Failure to Disclose Obviousness Combinations Based on the Siegel Patents (Dkt. 234) referenced herein shall be **EXTENDED** from December 31, 2018 to **JANUARY 7, 2019**.
