1 COURT SECURITY OFFICER: All rise.

2 THE COURT: Be seated, please.

3 All right. This is the time set for pre-trial  
4 matters to be taken up by the Court in two consolidated  
5 cases. These consolidated cases are AGIS versus HTC, the  
6 lead case, which is Case No. 2:17-CV-514, and the member  
7 case is AGIS versus LG, Case No. 2:17-CV-515.

8 The Court will call for announcements at this  
9 time.

10 What says the Plaintiff, AGIS?

11 MR. BAXTER: Good morning, Your Honor. Sam Baxter  
12 with McKool Smith along with my partner, Jennifer Truelove,  
13 Fred Fabricant, Peter Lambrianakos, and Vincent Rubino.  
14 We're ready, Your Honor, but I'm pleased to announce that  
15 we have settled both of these cases, Your Honor, as of this  
16 morning. And so, hopefully, the pretrial will be  
17 unnecessary.

18 THE COURT: All right. Mr. Baxter, that's very  
19 good news.

20 Let me get the announcements from the remaining  
21 parties.

22 What's the announcement from HTC?

23 MR. FINDLAY: Good morning, Your Honor. Eric  
24 Findlay on behalf of HTC. Also with me is my partner,

2 Wiggins, and I can confirm Mr. Baxter's representation that  
3 we have settled the case, Your Honor. We're ready to

6 What's the announcement for LG?

7 MR. MANN: Good morning, Your Honor. Mark Mann on  
8 behalf of LG. And with me today, Mike Berta, Nick Lee, and  
9 Dennis Blackburn, and I will confirm what Mr. Baxter said  
10 as of 7:30 this morning.

11 THE COURT: All right. Thank you.

12 Well, let me say this, counsel, you've made me a  
13 happy judge this morning. I want to commend all the  
14 parties for their hard work. I'm sure it was not easy.  
15 Settlements never are, but they're often the better part of  
16 valor. And with regard to these two cases, I'm pleased
