ZTE Corporation Appoints New Chief Export Compliance Officer to Enhance Regulatory Compliance Program

Officer to Oversee Export Control Program and Strengthen Company's Compliance and Training

November 14, 2016, Shenzhen, China – ZTE Corporation today announced the appointment of Mr. Matthew Bell as the company's Chief Export Compliance Officer and Legal Counsel, effective Oct. 28, 2016.
