### I. [AGREED] INTRODUCTION<sup>1</sup>

Ladies and Gentlemen of the Jury:

You've now heard the evidence in this case. I will now instruct you on the law that you must apply.

Each of you will have a copy of these final jury instructions that I am about to give you orally. You will have these for your review when you retire to the jury room to deliberate in a few moments.

It's your duty to follow the law as I give it to you. On the other hand, as I've said previously, you, the jury, are the sole judges of the facts. Do not consider any statement that I have made in the course of the trial or may make in these instructions as an indication that I have any opinion about the facts of the case. You are about to hear closing arguments from the attorneys for both of the parties. Statements and arguments of the attorneys are not evidence and are not instructions on the law. They are intended only to assist the jury in understanding the evidence and the parties' contentions.

### II. <u>GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS</u>

### A. Verdict Form

A verdict form has been prepared for you. You will take this form to the jury room, and when you have reached a unanimous agreement as to your verdict, you will have your foreperson fill in the blanks in that form, date it, and sign it. Answer each question in the verdict form from the facts as you find them. Do not decide who you think should win and then answer the questions to reach that result. Again, your answers and your verdict must be unanimous. [Samsung's Proposal: If you cannot reach a unanimous verdict, I will declare a mistrial, and set a date for a new trial.]<sup>2</sup>
