Counsel,

We have received AGIS Software's First Amended Disclosure of Asserted Claims and Infringement Contentions ("Amended Contentions"). While Uber does not agree that each of the amendments in these Amended Contentions to be proper, Uber considers these Amended Contentions to be AGIS's permitted supplement pursuant to Paragraph 3(a)(i) of the Discovery Order and AGIS's full and complete disclosure of the basis for its infringement allegations. As noted previously, months ago Uber made available source code sufficient to show the operation of any aspects or elements of the claims that Uber understood were accused based on AGIS Software's deficient infringement contentions served on May 19, 2021. Therefore, AGIS Software must seek leave of the Court, with a showing of good cause pursuant to Local Patent Rule 3-6(b), for any future amendments or supplementations.
