**ORDER DENYING PLAINTIFF AGIS SOFTWARE DEVELOPMENT LLC’S
MOTION TO COMPEL DEFENDANT UBER TECHNOLOGIES, INC. TO
PROVIDE DISCOVERY RELATING TO FOREIGN RIDES AND ORDERING
SANCTIONS AGAINST AGIS**

Before the Court is Plaintiff AGIS Software Development LLC’s (“AGIS”) motion to compel Defendant Uber Technologies, Inc. (“Uber”) to provide discovery relating to foreign rides (“Motion”). Having considered the Motion, the Court finds that the Motion should be denied, and that AGIS should be sanctioned for filing the motion.

Accordingly, the Court **DENIES** AGIS’s Motion to Compel Uber to provide discovery and **ORDERS** AGIS to pay Uber’s fees incurred in responding to the Motion.
