## Definition of vehicle

- 1 : a means of carrying or transporting something  
// planes, trains, and other *vehicles*  
: such as
  - a : MOTOR VEHICLE
  - b : a piece of mechanized equipment
- 2 : an agent of transmission : CARRIER
- 3 : a medium through which something is expressed, achieved, or displayed  
// an investment *vehicle*  
*especially* : a work created especially to display the talents of a particular performer
- 4 a : an inert medium (such as a syrup) in which a medicinally active agent is administered
  - b : any of various media acting usually as solvents, carriers, or binders for active ingredients or pigments

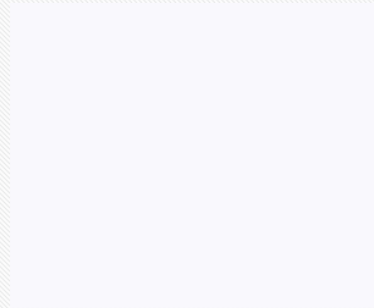

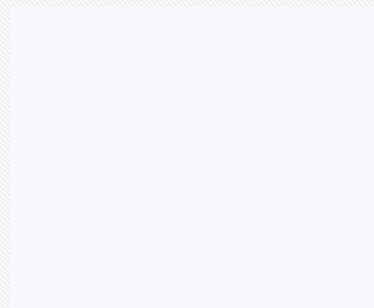

### History and Etymology for *vehicle*

borrowed from French & Latin; French *véhicule*, going back to Middle French, borrowed from Medieval Latin *vehiculum* "medium, agent of transmission," going back to Latin, "wheeled vehicle, means of transport," from *vehere* "to carry, convey" + *-culum*, instrumental suffix (going back to Indo-European *\*-tlom*) — more at [WAY entry 1](#)

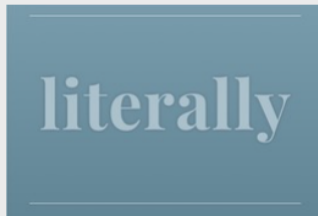

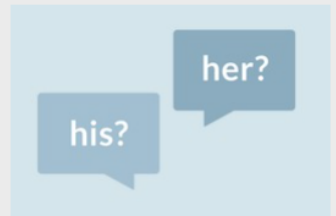
