**ORDER GRANTING AGREED MOTION FOR EXTENSIONS OF TIME TO
BRIEFING SCHEDULE FOR DEFENDANT LYFT, INC.’S
MOTION TO DISMISS FOR IMPROPER VENUE (DKT. 30)**

Before the Court is the Agreed Motion for Extensions of Time to Briefing Schedule for Defendant’s Motion to Dismiss for Improper Venue (Dkt. 30). Plaintiff AGIS Software Development LLC (“AGIS” or “Plaintiff”) and Defendant Lyft, Inc. (“Lyft” or “Defendant”) jointly request the following extensions of time to the briefing schedule:

- an extension of time for AGIS to file its Response to Lyft’s Motion to Dismiss for Improper Venue (Dkt. 30) from May 11, 2021 to on or before **May 25, 2021**;
- and
- An extension of time for Lyft to file its Reply to AGIS’s Response to Lyft’s Motion to Dismiss for Improper Venue (Dkt. 30) from May 18, 2021 to one or

before **June 15, 2021**.

Having considered the Motion, and in light of its agreed nature, the Court finds that it should be and hereby is **GRANTED**.

It is, therefore, **ORDERED** that AGIS file its Response to Lyft's Motion to Dismiss for Improper Venue (Dkt. 30) on or before **May 25, 2021** and Lyft file its Reply to AGIS's Response to Lyft's Motion to Dismiss for Improper Venue (Dkt. 30) on or before **June 15, 2021**.
