**ORDER GRANTING UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR EXTENSIONS OF TIME FOR
PLAINTIFF AGIS SOFTWARE DEVELOPMENT LLC’S SUR-REPLIES
TO DEFENDANT UBER TECHNOLOGIES, INC., d/b/a UBER’S
MOTION TO DISMISS (DKT. 24) AND MOTION TO STAY
PENDING RESOLUTION OF STANDING ISSUE (DKT. 25)**

Before the Court is the Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time for Plaintiff AGIS Software Development LLC’s (“AGIS” or “Plaintiff”) Sur-Replies to Defendant Uber Technologies, Inc., d/b/a Uber’s (“Uber” or “Defendant”) Motion to Dismiss (Dkt. 24) and Motion to Stay Pending Resolution of Standing Issue (Dkt. 25) as follows:

- AGIS to file its Sur-Reply to Uber’s Motion to Dismiss (Dkt. 24) from May 24, 2021 to on or before **May 31, 2021**; and

- AGIS to file its Sur-Reply to Uber's Motion to Stay Pending Resolution of Standing Order (Dkt. 25) from May 24, 2021 to on or before **May 31, 2021**.

Having considered the Motion, and in light of its unopposed nature, the Court finds that it should be and hereby is **GRANTED**.

It is, therefore, **ORDERED** that AGIS file its Sur-Reply to Uber's Motion to Dismiss (Dkt. 24) to on or before **May 31, 2021** and that AGIS to file its Sur-Reply to Uber's Motion to Stay Pending Resolution of Standing Order (Dkt. 25) to on or before **May 31, 2021**.
