**AFFIDAVIT OF SERVICE UPON DEFENDANT
TCL HOLDINGS (BVI) LIMITED**

Comes now Stanton Grazette, who, upon oath, states the following:

1. I am over the age of eighteen and authorized to serve process in the British Virgin Islands.
2. In the matters detailed herein, I was acting as agent for Dan Wise, Esq., a BVI Legal Practitioner admitted to practice in the British Virgin Islands and thus a competent person within the meaning of Article 10(b) of the 1965 Convention on the Service Abroad of Judicial and Extrajudicial Documents in Civil or Commercial Matters (the Hague Service Convention).
3. Mr. Wise was in turn acting at the request of Aaron Lukken, Esq. of Kansas City, Missouri, himself instructed by plaintiff's counsel, Matthew Karambelas, Esq.
4. On Tuesday, May 17, 2022, I was instructed by Mr. Wise to serve upon defendant TCL Holdings (BVI) Limited (TCL Holdings) the following documents in the case at bar:

- Complaint for Patent Infringement
- Civil Cover Sheet

5. The Hague Service Convention Warning and Summary documents are attached here as Exhibit A.

6. According to plaintiff's counsel, the defendant is a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the British Virgin Islands, with its principal place of business in Hong Kong.

Based upon a search of the British Virgin Islands corporate registry, TCL Holdings' registered agent was discovered to be Vistra (BVI) Limited (Vistra), Vistra Corporate Services Centre, Wickhams Cay II, Road Town, Tortola, British Virgin Islands. The British Virgin Islands corporate registry search report for TCL Overseas is attached as Exhibit B.

8. At approximately 3:56 pm on Tuesday, May 17, 2022, I attended the above referenced address with the intention of completing service upon TCL Holdings.

9. Upon my arrival, I advised the person at the front desk that I was there to service papers on TCL Holdings (BVI) Limited and asked for the person who was authorized to sign on its behalf.


