FINDLAY: Just we have a possible witness issue 8 with Mansoorian that I don't know if we have resolved yet. 9 One of our witnesses, Mr. Mansoorian -- we have discussed it with Maxell, we have told them about it -- has 10 to be in California on Tuesday. And so we were wondering if 11 12 perhaps we could put him on Monday out of order potentially. 13 MS. BJURSTROM: No. 14 MR. FINDLAY: Oh, sorry. 15 THE COURT: Ms. Bjurstrom, do you want to address 16 this? 17 MS. BJURSTROM: Yes, Your Honor. I sent an e-mail 18 a couple of days ago to the other side to let them know that 19 things -- the timing has been a little different than we 20 thought for some of the witnesses, and so one of their last 21 witnesses is going to be Dr. Madisetti, and he hasn't gone on 22 yet. 23 And it looks like if Dr. Phinney hasn't gone, we've 24 got Dr. Madisetti still to go kind of way towards the end of 25 the order.

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1	And, obviously, Dr. Mansoorian would like to be
2	able to sit and listen to Dr. Madisetti.
3	He had in the two-week period of time that we
4	he similar to Dr. Caloyannides he had one day, Tuesday
5	of next week, where he needed to be in the Bay Area for a
6	long scheduled meeting.
7	So I had asked whether we could put Dr well, I
8	said, you know, Dr. Mansoorian could testify like Monday
9	morning or Wednesday afternoon. He could be here for

20	THE COURT: Okay. Thoughts from the Plaintiffs?
21	MR. LEVY: Thank you, Your Honor.
22	I think we were aware that Dr. Mansoorian had a
23	scheduling issue and might be out of order, but I don't think
24	we had any of the details.
25	But maybe now that we have the details, we can talk
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1 about it. I'm not quite sure what relief they're asking for. 2 We still have two witnesses, two experts, and some deposition 3 clips and, you know, we've -- we've been handling roughly two a day. So, hopefully, we can get them both done on Monday. 4 5 If the issue is that Dr. Mansoorian sooner won't be 6 able to go on Tuesday, I think that's fine. He could 7 probably go on Wednesday. 8 Again, I'm -- I think there's some confusion on our 9 part because we're not sure what relief they're actually 10 asking for. So maybe that's something we can discuss over 11 the weekend. 12 MS. BJURSTROM: Well, if they're just willing to 13 work it out with us, like we worked it out with 14 Dr. Caloyannides, I think that would be appreciated. So we 15 just haven't heard anything. 16 THE COURT: Well, I don't -- I'm going to expect 17 the same from either of you, to try -- try your very best to work it out. 18 19 MR. LEVY: Absolutely. We -- we don't have any 20 issue. We're just not quite sure what the issue is, and 21 we're happy to work with them to kind of figure it out. 22 THE COURT: I mean, you know, I've had this come up 23 a time or two in other cases where there was, you know, a 24 longer trial and we asked the witness to sit for a deposition 25 over the weekend and, you know, when we got to that part of

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
