**[PROPOSED] ORDER GRANTING MAXELL, LTD.'S POST-TRIAL MOTIONS AND
RENEWED MOTION FOR JUDGMENT AS A MATTER OF LAW**

Having considered Maxell, Ltd.'s post-trial motions and renewed motion for judgment as a matter of law, the Court is of the opinion that these motions should be **GRANTED**.

Accordingly, judgment is granted for Maxell on ZTE's Counterclaims IV and XII.

Moreover, judgment is granted awarding Maxell the following damages:

- Jury award of \$43,300,000.00;
- Enhancement of the jury award by 100% (\$43,300,000.00);
- Pre-judgment interest on the jury award at the prime rate compounded quarterly from January 1, 2011;
- Post-judgment interest on the entire sum entered as final judgment at the statutory rate pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1961;
- Costs of \$154,178.10; and
- Attorney's fees, subject to the parties filing a notice within fourteen days detailing the agreed amount of fees or any disputes.
