





Within 3 Weeks, Pay the US\$1,283 Reservation Fee

- The reservation fee must be paid by U.S. postal money order or certified bank check made payable to the "U.S. Embassy, Tokyo, Japan" or "U.S. Consulate General Osaka-Kobe, Japan" as appropriate.
- · The reservation fee is non-refundable.
- · Personal or corporate checks are not acceptable.
- . All funds must be in U.S. dollars and checks must be drawn on a U.S. bank.
- Your reservation is not final until we receive the reservation fee. If the fee is not received within 3
 weeks, the dates will be released to others without further notice.

6 Weeks Prior to the Deposition

- · Send a certified copy of the court order/commission and statutory deposition fees.
- Please note that your reservation will be cancelled without further notice if we do not receive them six weeks prior to the deposition. <u>Deposition Order/Commission</u>
