## <u>ORDER</u>

Before the Court is an Emergency Opposed Motion to Stay Pending Transfer (ECF 99) filed by Defendants Emerson Electric Co., Fisher-Rosemount Systems, Inc., and Rosemount Inc. The Court entered an Order on July 1, 2016 granting Defendants' motion to transfer the claims against them to the United States District Court for the Northern District of Georgia. Pursuant to Local Rule CV-83(b), absent an order to the contrary the Clerk may not transmit the case to the directed court until the twenty-first day after the transfer order is entered. Defendants assert that all upcoming deadlines in the case should be vacated pending the transfer. The parties' P.R. 4-3 Joint Claim Construction and Prehearing Statement are currently due on July 7, 2016. After due consideration, the Court determines that expedited briefing is appropriate. It is therefore

**ORDERED** that any response to the Emergency Opposed Motion to Stay Pending Transfer is due no later than **July 8, 2016**. It is further



**ORDERED** that the current deadlines in the case are stayed pending a ruling on the Emergency Opposed Motion to Stay Pending Transfer.
