MEMORANDUM OPINION

This is an appeal from the trial court's final judgment signed on October 8, 2019. Appellant's brief was originally due on December 3, 2019. On December 17, 2019, we issued a notice advising appellant that unless her brief was filed within ten days, we might dismiss the appeal for want of prosecution. Appellant has neither



timely filed a brief nor requested an extension. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 38.8(a)(1) (the appellate court may dismiss for want of prosecution for failure to file appellant's brief).

Accordingly, we dismiss the appeal for want of prosecution. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 38.8(a)(1), 42.3(b), 43.2(f). We dismiss all pending motions as moot.
