TRIAL COURT'S CERTIFICATION OF DEFENDANT'S RIGHT OF APPEAL\*

- The defendant has waived the right of appeal.





I understand that, because of appellate deadline, if I fail to timely inform my appellate attorney of any change in my address, I may lose the opportunity to file a *pro se* petition for discretionary review.



\* "A defendant in a criminal case has the right of appeal under these rules. The trial court shall enter a certification of the defendant's right to appeal in every case in which it enters a judgement of guilt or other appealable order. In a plea bargain case-that is, a case in which a defendant's plea was
