**ORDER MODIFYING PROBATION JUDGMENT
AND EXTENDING PERIOD OF PROBATION**

On April 03, 2017, KIMBERLY ANGUIANO, was placed on 1 year probation for the offense of DRIVING WHILE INTOXICATED. The Court, in accordance with Article 42A.752 (a)(2), extends the period of probation not to exceed 24 months, commencing on December 02, 2018. All conditions of probation ordered on the original probation period and any amendments thereof, remain in full force and effect during the extension period.

That said Judgment of Probation should be modified by:

[XXX] Adding the following condition(s)

[33.] Defendant shall acquire a portable handheld alcohol device that uses a deep-lung breath analysis mechanism to document if ethyl alcohol is detected on the breath of the defendant; participate in the program as directed by the Hidalgo County Community Supervision & Corrections Department for a period of **ONE (1)** year commencing **INSTANTER**. The defendant shall pay all costs directly to the vendor, avoid tampering with the device, and abide by all guidelines, instructions and rules of the participant agreement. The defendant gives the service provider the authority to release any and all information pertaining to his/her total participation in the program to the Hidalgo County Community Supervision and Corrections Department.

[34.] That defendant attend **ONE (1)** Alcoholics Anonymous meeting per week commencing **INSTANTER** for a period of **SIX (6) MONTHS** and that he/she provide proof of said attendance to his/her probation officer each time that he/she reports.

and it appearing to the Court that probationer had been informed by the Hidalgo County Community Supervision & Corrections Department of said Motion, and the Court having examined the pleadings executed by the probationer therein, is of the opinion that said motion be and is hereby granted and the Judgment is hereby modified as set forth above and that a certified copy of this Order be delivered by the Clerk of this Court to the defendant and probationer herein.







That said Judgment of Probation should be modified by:


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
