

advanced setup options

advanced setup options Options in the BIOS setup program that let you choose PCI interrupts, port addresses, and hard disk setup options.

Advanced Technology Attachment Packet Interface (ATAPI) A standard that makes it very easy to connect a CD-ROM drive to an Enhanced IDE host adapter.

AFAIK Abbreviation for "as far as I know." Commonly used abbreviation on Internet Relay Chat (IRC), chat rooms, e-mail, and Usenet.

AFK Abbreviation for "away from keyboard." Commonly used on Internet Relay Chat (IRC) and chat rooms.

aftermarket The market for *software* and *peripherals* created by the sale of large numbers of a specific brand of computer or software. See *add-in program*.

agate A 5.5-point type size often used in newspaper classified advertisements and financial tables.

agent 1. A program specifically designed to interact with a server and access data on the user's behalf; synonymous with client. 2. An automatic program that is designed to operate on the user's behalf, performing a specific function in the background. When the agent has achieved its goal, it reports to the user. In the future, agents may roam the world's computer networks, looking for information and reporting only when the information has been retrieved.

aggregate function In database management programs, a command that performs arithmetic operations on the values in a specific field in all the records within a database, or in one view of the database.

aggregate operator In a database management program, a command that tells the program to perform an aggregate function.

AGP See Accelerated Graphics Port.

AI See artificial intelligence.

AIFF An 8-bit monaural sound file format developed by Apple Computer for storing digitized wave sounds. The format is also widely found on Silicon Crapbics workstations and in G
