ORDER GRANTING JOINT MOTION TO STAY PENDING INTER PARTES REVIEW

Upon consideration of the Stipulation and Joint Motion to Stay Pending *Inter Partes* Review filed by Plaintiff Ancora Technologies, Inc., and Roku, Inc, and for good cause shown in view of the instituted *inter partes* review (“IPR”) petition as to the ’941 Patent,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The above-captioned case is hereby stayed.
2. The parties shall submit a joint status report within 10 days after the PTAB has issued Final Written Decisions in both the Nintendo IPR and the VIZIO/Roku IPR, or by March 10, 2023, whichever is earlier.
3. The parties shall file a joint request for a status conference to take place within 30 days after the PTAB has issued Final Written Decisions in both the Nintendo IPR and the VIZIO/Roku IPR. The parties may request that the Court re-open all or part of this case, or keep the stay in place (*e.g.*, pending any appeals to the Federal Circuit) at that time.
