**UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR ENTRY OF AGREED
AMENDED SCHEDULING ORDER**

Defendants Meta Platforms, Inc.¹ and Facebook Technologies, LLC (collectively, “Meta” or “Defendants”) move for entry of the Agreed Amended Scheduling Order (the “Agreed Order”) detailed below. Plaintiffs Gentex Corporation and Indigo Technologies, LLC (collectively, “Gentex” or “Plaintiffs”) do not oppose this motion. The requested and agreed upon changes to the existing Scheduling Order are, as follows:

The Agreed Order modifies the date for the opening brief and shifts the deadline for the ensuing submissions, as follows: (a) providing a six-day extension for the Opening Claim Construction brief; (b) shifting the deadline for each ensuing brief by one-week, and (c) providing a five-day extension for the Parties to submit the Joint Claim Construction Statement. The Parties

have agreed that neither Defendants nor Plaintiffs will submit a technical tutorial. The modifications do not impact the *Markman* hearing set for April 25, 2022.
