MOTION TO WITHDRAW DOCUMENT (ECF NO. 10)

Without prejudice and waiver of its right to re-file, Plaintiff ParkerVision, Inc. moves to withdraw its Motion for Leave to Effect Alternate Service on Defendant Realtek Semiconductor Corp. Due to Defendant's refusal to plead or otherwise defend the allegations of ParkerVision's Complaint for Patent Infringement, and because Defendant was properly served pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 4(f)(2)(c)(ii), ParkerVision no longer requests leave to effect alternative service. Instead, ParkerVision intends to apply to the court for a default judgment after the Clerk of Court enters Defendant's default. Accordingly, ParkerVision requests Plaintiff ParkerVision, Inc.'s Motion for Leave to Effect Alternative Service on Realtek Semiconductor Corp. (ECF No. 10) be withdrawn from the docket.
