## JOINT MOTION TO MODIFY SCHEDULING ORDER



Pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 16 and Local Rule 7, RAI Strategic Holdings, Inc. and R.J. Reynolds Vapor Company ("Reynolds") and Altria Client Services LLC, Philip Morris USA Inc., and Philip Morris Products S.A. (collectively, "Counterclaim Plaintiffs") (together, the "Parties") hereby submit this Joint Motion To Modify Scheduling Order.

The parties agreed on May 27, 2021, to jointly request a modification of the Scheduling Order.
