
**ORDER NO. 18: GRANTING UNOPPOSED MOTION TO AMEND PROCEDURAL
SCHEDULE**

(March 27, 2015)

On March 26, 2015, Complainant NVIDIA Corporation (“NVIDIA”) and Respondents Samsung Electronics Co., Ltd., Samsung Electronics America, Inc., Samsung Telecommunications America, LLC, and Samsung Semiconductor, Inc. and Qualcomm, Inc. (collectively, “Respondents”) filed an unopposed joint motion to amend the Procedural Schedule (Order No. 9). The motion indicates that the Staff does not oppose the motion. Complainant and Respondents argue good cause exists for the proposed amendments in light of the number of experts and size of their respective reports.
