Flip to mute



If your phone is facing up when a call comes in, turn the phone over to mute it. If you go to Settings and then tap Sound & notification > Flip to mute, you can set your phone to:

Mute only once after flipping the phone. While the **Mute** phone is still facing down, it will ring again when there are other incoming calls.


