**ORDER ON MOTION TO COMPEL**

On March 5, 2024, Defendant filed an Emergency Motion to Compel Plaintiff's production of materials from *Regeneron Pharms., Inc. v. Mylan Pharms., Inc.*, No. 1:22-cv-00061 in response to Defendant's Request for Production No. 4. [ECF No. 122] Plaintiff filed a response on March 6, 2024. Now, therefore, for good cause shown, the Court **GRANTS IN PART** Defendant Celltrion, Inc.'s Motion to Compel, as set forth below.

1. Plaintiff shall produce to Defendant Celltrion, Inc. the Mylan Litigation Materials (as defined in Plaintiff's Response (page 1-2, note 1) within seven (7) days of the entry of this Order. Plaintiff shall produce unredacted copies of the aforementioned documents unless Mylan Pharmaceuticals Inc. provides redacted copies of said documents to Plaintiff no later than 9:00 am on the day such production is due to be made by Plaintiff.
2. All documents produced by Regeneron in response to this Order shall be maintained by Celltrion on an Outside Counsel Eye's Only basis.
3. Plaintiff shall serve this order on counsel for Mylan Pharmaceuticals Inc within one business day of the entry of this Order.

It is so **ORDERED**.
