**MOTION TO PARTIALLY WITHDRAW
MOTIONS FOR PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION**

On February 22, 2024, Plaintiff Regeneron Pharmaceuticals, Inc. (“Regeneron”) filed Motions for Preliminary Injunction against Samsung Bioepis, Celltrion, and Formycon (“Defendants”) seeking relief in connection with infringement of U.S. Patent No. 11,084,865 as to all Defendants and various other patents with respect to certain Defendants. In an effort to streamline the issues in dispute in the Preliminary Injunction motions, Regeneron moves to withdraw its Motions for Preliminary Injunction with respect to patents other than U.S. Patent No. 11,084,865. As a result, Regeneron’s Motions for Preliminary Injunction now seek the same relief as to all Defendants—a preliminary injunction in connection with infringement of U.S. Patent No. 11,084,865. Regeneron’s proposed preliminary injunction order submitted on Friday, May 24, 2024 will address only U.S. Patent No. 11,084,865 and will not address the various other patents.
