

LISTING OF THE CLAIMS

This listing of claims replaces all prior versions and listings of claims in the application:

1. (Currently Amended) A mobile lawyer system comprising:
 - at least one video camera configured for mounting inside the passenger compartment of a vehicle and capture video images of at least one passenger passengers in the vehicle;
 - a display screen configured for mounting inside the passenger compartment of a vehicle;
 - a remote server and a database configured to store information about a plurality of lawyers licensed in a plurality of jurisdictions;
 - a mobile device executing a mobile application and in wireless communication with the video camera and display screen, configured, upon command from the at least one passenger a user, to communicate with the remote server, wherein the remote server is configured to automatically determine a location of the vehicle, automatically identify a jurisdiction associated with the vehicle location, automatically identify at least one lawyer licensed in the identified jurisdiction, and automatically notify one of the at least one identified lawyer an attorney located remotely; and
 - the display screen configured to automatically live-stream a video image of the remote lawyer attorney, and the at least one video camera is configured to automatically live-stream video captured by the at least one video camera for viewing by the remote lawyer attorney and for storage in the remote database, where the at least one mobile device being configured to enable bi-directional audio and video communication between the remote lawyer and the at least one passenger.
2. (Original) The mobile lawyer system of claim 1, wherein the at least one video camera comprises a 360-degree high definition video camera configured to capture video images in a plurality of directions.
3. (Original) The mobile lawyer system of claim 1, wherein the at least one video camera comprises a video camera mounted on a drone.

4. (Original) The mobile lawyer system of claim 1, wherein the at least video camera comprises a plurality of video cameras mounted on the vehicle configured to capture video images in a plurality of directions.

5. (Currently Amended) The mobile lawyer system of claim 1, wherein the database is configured to store information about a plurality of licensed lawyers, including in which jurisdiction where each lawyer is licensed, and contact information for each lawyer.

6. (Original) The mobile lawyer system of claim 1, wherein the database is configured to store encrypted data.

7. (Currently Amended) The mobile lawyer system of claim 1, wherein the remote lawyer attorney is able to receive and view the live-streamed video data of the at least one passenger user on a computing device, which is also configured to capture video images of the remote lawyer attorney and transmit them to the remote server.

8. (Currently Amended) The mobile lawyer system of claim 1, further comprising at least one video camera configured for mounting outside the passenger compartment of the vehicle and capture video images of at least one passenger passengers in the vehicle and surrounding environment.

9. (Withdrawn) A mobile lawyer method comprising:
receiving a consultation request from a user's mobile device;
initiating capture of images of the user and surroundings, and live-streaming the captured images to a remote server for storage via a computer network in response to the consultation request;
determining a location of the user;
identifying at least one remote lawyer in response to the determined location of the user;
generating and sending an alert to the at least one remote lawyer;
receiving at least one response from the at least one remote lawyer;
selecting one lawyer from the at least one remote lawyer who sent a response;

additionally live-streaming captured images of the user to the selected lawyer; and receiving live-streaming images of the selected lawyer and transmitting them to a display monitor viewable by the user.

10. (Withdrawn) The mobile lawyer method of claim 9, wherein initiating capture of images of the user and surroundings comprises initiating a 360-degree capture of video images of the user and surroundings.

11. (Withdrawn) The mobile lawyer method of claim 9, wherein initiating capture of images of the user and surroundings comprises initiating a capture of video images by a video camera mounted on a drone.

12. (Withdrawn) The mobile lawyer method of claim 11, further comprising receiving remote control input of a flight path and position of the drone.

13. (Withdrawn) The mobile lawyer method of claim 9, wherein receiving a consultation request comprises receiving a user input via a mobile application executing on the user's mobile device.

14. (Withdrawn) The mobile lawyer method of claim 9, wherein live-streaming the captured images to a remote server comprises transmitting the captured images via at least one of the Internet and cellular network.

15. (Withdrawn) The mobile lawyer method of claim 9, wherein determining a location of the user comprises accessing a GPS location of the user.

16. (Withdrawn) The mobile lawyer method of claim 9, wherein identifying at least one remote lawyer comprises accessing a remote database storing information associated with a plurality of lawyers licensed in various jurisdictions.

17. (Withdrawn) The mobile lawyer method of claim 16, wherein identifying at least one remote lawyer comprises to identifying remote lawyers licensed in a jurisdiction that matches the location of the user.

18. (Withdrawn) The mobile lawyer method of claim 16, wherein identifying at least one remote lawyer comprises to identifying remote lawyers with high rating.

19. (Withdrawn) The mobile lawyer method of claim 9, wherein generating and sending an alert comprises transmitting at least one of a call, a text message, an email address to the at least one remote lawyer.

20. (Withdrawn) The mobile lawyer method of claim 9, wherein selecting one lawyer comprises selecting a lawyer with high rating.

21. (Withdrawn) The mobile lawyer method of claim 9, wherein selecting one lawyer comprises selecting a lawyer that responded first.

22. (Withdrawn) The mobile lawyer method of claim 9, wherein receiving live-streaming images of the selected lawyer comprises receiving the live-streaming images by the user's mobile device and transmitting the live-streaming images for display to the display monitor mounted on the dash board of the vehicle.

23. (Withdrawn) A mobile lawyer method comprising:
receiving a consultation request from a user's mobile device;
initiating capture of images of the user using a 360-degree video camera and live-streaming the captured video images to a remote server via a computer network in response to the consultation request;
storing the captured live-streaming video images in a remote database in communication with the remote server;

accessing a database storing information associated with a plurality of lawyers, and identifying at least one lawyer licensed to practice law in a jurisdiction corresponding to a location of the user;

generating and contacting the at least one lawyer;

receiving at least one response from the at least one lawyer;

selecting one lawyer from the at least one lawyer who sent a response;

live-streaming the captured live-streaming video images of the user to the selected lawyer;

and

displaying at least one image of the selected lawyer on a display monitor viewable by the user.

24. (Withdrawn) The mobile lawyer method of claim 23, wherein initiating capture of images of the user and surroundings comprises initiating a capture of video images by a video camera mounted on a drone.

25. (Withdrawn) The mobile lawyer method of claim 24, further comprising receiving remote control input of a flight path and position of the drone.

26. (Withdrawn) The mobile lawyer method of claim 23, wherein receiving a consultation request comprises receiving a user input via a mobile application executing on the user's mobile device.

27. (Withdrawn) The mobile lawyer method of claim 23, wherein live-streaming the captured images to a remote server comprises transmitting the captured images via at least one of the Internet and cellular network.

28. (Withdrawn) The mobile lawyer method of claim 23, wherein determining a location of the user comprises accessing a GPS location of the user.
